3. I am active in Friends of San Onofre and am on the board of directors of the Naturist Action Committee.
4. Due to the uncertainty of the status of the "Cahill Policy", I am in imminent danger of arrest and criminal prosecution if I participate in nude sunbathing at San Onofre.

1 5. As a member of the public, I have relied on the "Cahill Policy" as  
2 a statement of regulation regarding the enforcement at San Onofre.

3 6. As a member of the public, I have not had legally-prescribed  
4 notice of revocation of the "Cahill Policy". Nor have I been afforded  
5 an opportunity to be heard regarding revocation.

6 Request for Hearing Denied by RUTH COLEMAN

7 7. On 7-2-08, Robert Morton, Executive Director of the NATURIST  
8 ACTION COMMITTEE and I met with RUTH COLEMAN at her office in  
9 Sacramento. During that meeting, we requested that the DEPARTMENT OF  
10 PARKS & RECREATION hold public hearings on the rescission of the  
11 "Cahill Policy", as former Director Cahill held prior to implementing  
12 the Policy in 1979. Director COLEMAN denied this request out of hand.
